NoteBurner Music One for Windows is a powerful all-in-one streaming music converter which supports downloading music from Spotify, Apple Music, Amazon Music, Tidal, YouTube Music, Deezer, Pandora Music, Line Music, YouTube, SoundCloud, Dailymotion, Vimeo, and Veoh. Once the output parameters are set, this tool will effortlessly extract streaming tracks as MP3, AAC, FLAC, WAV, AIFF, and ALAC files, with pristine ID3 tags preserved. More than that, the program is capable of batch converting your cherry-pick playlists at up to 10X faster speed without losing any audio quality.

Thanks to the top-notch recording core, NoteBurner Music One is flexible in capturing audio content via App Mode and Web Mode. Also, you can choose to record streaming music songs in real-time. Of course, for further personalise the converted audio, users can make use of the in-built utilities such as a format converter, CD burner, and tags editor.

1. Why should I buy NoteBurner Music One for Windows?

NoteBurner Music One for Windows is a shareware, the trial version of which is limited to convert the first **1 minute** of each audio. To unlock the limitation, a license key is needed. Once you purchase the program, you will receive a confirmation e-mail with your registration ID and product key in it toget the access to the full version.


2. How can I benefit from purchasing a license?

Register NoteBurner Music One for Windows

Step 1: Launch NoteBurner Music One on your PC. You can see a simple and concise interface.

Step 2: Please click the "**Register**" icon (on the bottom left). There will be a registration popup dialog, where you can copy and paste the registration email and license code.





Notice:

- 1. Please register and launch the program with stable network connection.
- 2. Please make sure you've paid the program to get license info to unlock the limitations of the trial version. If not, please click **Buy now** to complete the purchase.
- 3. The registration information is case sensitive. Please do not add blank at the beginning or at the end of the registration e-mail and code.


Installation

To install the program, please follow the instructions below step by step:

- 1. Download and install NoteBurner Music One for Windows from Download Center.
- 2. Double click the installation package of NoteBurner Music One for Windows to begin the installation process.
- 3. Follow the instructions to finish the installation.

Main Interface


Launch NoteBurner Music One for Windows and you will find different streaming music options are shown on the main interface. Here users can choose a specific music service and download mode.






Menu

Click the "Menu" button on the upper-right, and you will see a dialogue as below:



Settings


Click the button on the bottom left, and you will see a pop-up window as below, where you can set Output Format, Bit Rate, Sample Rate, Output Folder, Output File Name, and more.





Audio Tools

After the convertion, free audio editor tools are also available. Go to "**Tools**" on the left tap, user are able to personalize tracks by using built-in format converter, CD burner, and tags editor.



Choose Download Port


Launch NoteBurner Music One program, then you'll select a music streaming service and conversion mode. Let's start with an example of "Spotify App" conversion.





Select Output Format


Click the button on the bottom left to set up convert settings. Just select Output Format (AUTO/MP3/AAC/WAV/FLAC/AIFF/ALAC), Bit Rate (320kbps, 256kbps, 192kbps, 128kbps), Sample Rate, Output Folder, Output File Name, and more.






Add Tracks to NoteBurner

Directly drag & drop the playlists from Spotify app to NoteBurner, or you can also copy and paste the playlist link to the parsing box of NoteBurner. Then tick the songs that you want to convert, click "Add".




Note: If you've previously selected the Web Download Mode for Spotify, you can directly open a Spotify playlist, album, or artist on the web play window, and tap the icon to input songs to NoteBurner.





Start Converting Songs


Click the **"Convert"** button and the program will start downloading Spotify songs to the computer. You can see the progress bar on the **"Converting"** interface.





Check Converted Audio Files


Once converted successfully, you can find the downloaded of Spotify Music files by clicking "Converted", hovering to the music list, and clicking the small "Folder" icon.





Edit ID3 Tags


NoteBurner Music One provides a free tool to edit ID3 tags by your own. Just go to "**Tools > Edit Tag**" and you will get this tool to customize the metadata as needs.





Convert Formats of Local Audio


Apart from music conversion, NoteBurner also supports to convert your local music files to MP3, M4A, FLAC, WAV, OGG, and AIFF. Click "Tool > Format Converter" and you will find this audio converter.





Burn Converted Music to CD


On the toolbox menu, you can utilize the CD burner. This tool allows you to burn both converted streaming music or local music songs onto a CD. All you need is to follow the instruction and your music will be burned instantly.





Convert AA/AAX Audiobooks

In the toolbox, there's a paid tool - AA/AAX Converter, which is designed to convert your local aa or aax audiobooks to M4A, M4B or MP3 format easily.
